

DUTIES OF OASIS AMBASSADORS

1. He is the Potentate's representative to all the Nobility in his jurisdiction and, from time to time, may be asked to contact certain nobles with regard to Oasis business.
2. He is the Potentate's designated Membership liaison, with the responsibility for coordinating Oasis membership programs with the officers of his assigned club and with the Oasis Membership Committee, and reports to the District Trustee on membership activities.
3. He should visit regularly with the Blue Lodges in his jurisdiction and attend as many Scottish and York Rite meetings as possible, and make every effort to urge any and all new Masons to petition the Shrine.
4. He should keep himself briefed on the activities of Oasis, such as dates and locations of ceremonials and other important events, and be prepared to advise anyone with regard to these events. He should also make every effort to participate in all Oasis programs (ceremonials, business meetings, etc.), and should attend Oasis Orientation sessions so that he might be brief and become knowledgeable of his duties and the business of Oasis.
5. He should call on the sick, convey the well wishes of the Potentate and Oasis for their speedy recovery and notify Oasis of any serious or lingering illnesses.
6. He should call at the homes (or wherever the family is receiving) of members who have been summoned by the Black Camel, and convey the sympathy of the Potentate and Oasis to the bereaved family.
7. He should advise Oasis by mail, phone or e-mail the date of death of any Noble in his jurisdiction. He should advise Oasis at the same time who the immediate survivor is in order that notification regarding any Hospital memorial is addressed properly.
8. He should keep Oasis informed of any publicity concerning the Shrine in his area (both on the general membership and club level), clip and mail to Oasis any newspaper items, being sure that the date of publication is shown.
9. He should be the one to whom all Nobles in his area can go to for advice regarding anything connected with Oasis affairs.
10. He should be prepared at the conclusion of his term to make a recommendation to the incoming Potentate at least three (3) Nobles in his jurisdiction who have distinguished themselves as Masons and Shriners and who should be considered as potential Ambassadors.
